

## January 31, 2018

The Board of County Commissioners of Creek County (BOCC) met in Emergency Session on Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., date and time duly posted.

**Item #1:** Meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Vice-Chairman, Newt Stephens, Jr. Roll Call Warner absent, Stephens present, and Whitehouse present.

**Item #2:** Statement of compliance with open meeting act-Vice-Chairman.

**Item #3:** Motion was made by Whitehouse and seconded by Stephens to sign **Resolution#2018-10** implementing a 14 day Burn Ban for Creek County. Andrew Goforth, Assistant District Attorney spoke to the Board about the implementation per Title 2 O.S. § 16-26 and 25 O.S. § 304(5) and procedures followed. Covey Murray, Emergency Management stated he has contacted Bristow, Drumright, Kiefer, Mannford, Sapulpa, Kellyville, Depew and Slick Fire Departments. They are all in favor of the burn ban. Goforth explained the Agricultural exemptions and procedures. Bret Bowling stated he can send out a teletype out about burn ban. Murray stated he will contact media. Goforth in closing discussed the possible prosecution of anyone caught violating the burn ban as per Title 2 O.S. § 16-26(B)(10). Vote as follows: Stephens - Aye, Whitehouse - Aye.
